Each year, Childhood Cancer Support organises a free camping getaway for families – those who have stayed with us in the past, those who are staying with us now, and others who are dealing with the impacts of childhood cancer.

Camp Crystal is for families of children who are presently facing or have faced childhood cancer, regardless of what stage they are currently at. Some families may have children who are newly diagnosed, some may be in remission, some may be long-term survivors and others may be parents or siblings of those who have passed.

Filled with fun activities suitable for the whole family, Camp Crystal is a weekend-escape for families and parents to recharge and remind themselves that there is a life to be lived outside of hospital appointments and treatments, and a place where you can come to enjoy yourself, relax and reflect.

We are excited to be writing to you as Camp Crystal planning is well under way and applications for attending camp 2019 have now opened.

Camp Crystal has again partnered with Scouts Queensland and will be held at the Baden Powell Park, Samford QLD. A short 23km drive from the heart of the Brisbane CBD, surrounded by bushland.

Camp will begin at lunch on Friday 12th April and ends after lunch on Sunday the 14th April 2019. Interest levels are high so please note spaces are **limited** and therefore a place cannot always be guaranteed. It is important that your applications are in by the 4th March 2019.

I _____ (applicant's name) hereby apply to attend Camp Crystal. In so applying, and in consideration of my application for attending Camp Crystal being accepted, I acknowledge and agree that:

1. If accepted my participation in Camp Crystal is subject to my complying with the terms and conditions of Camp Crystal, this declaration and any reasonable direction issued by Camp Crystal organizers or their representatives.
2. Camp Crystal rules and this declaration comprise a contract between Childhood Cancer Support, its Supporters, and myself. It is necessary and reasonable for promoting and conducting Camp Crystal.
3. This document cannot be amended. If I do amend it, my application will be null and void.
4. Warning: Risks (including but not limited to over-exertion, equipment failure, dehydration, serious accidents, and weather conditions) can and do happen which may result in me being personally injured or my property being damaged. I have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks.
5. Insurance is in place that provides limited cover to me whilst I am participating in Camp Crystal. I understand that this insurance may not cover me for all injury, loss or damage sustained by me and I can, in my own interests, seek and obtain personal insurances over and above the cover provided.
6. Exclusion of Liability: Except where provided or required by law and such cannot be excluded, I agree that it is a condition of my entry to Camp Crystal that Childhood Cancer Support and its Supporters are absolved from all liability however arising from injury or damage however caused (whether fatal or otherwise) arising out of my participation in Camp Crystal.
7. Release and Indemnity: In consideration of Childhood Cancer Support (CCS) accepting my application for entry into Camp Crystal, I release and forever discharge CCS and its Supporters from all claims that I may have or may have had, but for this release arising CCS and its Supporters to the extent permitted by law and in respect of any Claim by any person, including but not only another participant in Camp Crystal, arising as a result of or in connection with my participation in Camp Crystal. In this clause "Claims" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, penalty, cost, or expense however rising but does not include a claim in respect of any action, suit, etc. made by any person entitled to make a claim under a relevant event insurance policy.

- Prevailing conditions: Camp Crystal is predominantly an outdoor event. I acknowledge that Camp Crystal Organisers cannot control the weather and associated conditions.
- Conduct: I understand that Childhood Cancer Support (CCS) is a charitable family-oriented organization and I agree to behave at all times relating to Camp Crystal in a way which upholds family and CCS values and the integrity and good reputation of CCS.
- I authorise Childhood Cancer Support and Event Organisers to seek medical treatment on my behalf should it be required.

Definitions for the purposes of this declaration:

- "I/We" (me/my/etc) means and includes myself a responsible and capable adult, and all children under my guardianship in attendance at this Event.

- "Its supporters" means and includes all supporting individuals and organizations, including the Commonwealth of Australia Department of Defence, their members and their respective directors, officers, employees, members, servants or agents.

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Camp Rules

A quick note to our families:

Please feel free to participate in as many or as little activities as you like. If you just want to sit under a tree or read a book, that's fine too. All we ask is that you please observe some of the following rules that are put in place for you and your children's safety.

For legal reasons we also have to advise the camper families and our volunteers of our code of behaviour for voluntary workers.

If you have any questions or problems please refer to persons identified at the beginning of camp - they will endeavour to help, or find someone who can.

The following areas are OUT OF BOUNDS to all campers:

- ♥ All waterways including creeks and dams.
- ♥ Sheds, fire tending and kitchen areas.
- ♥ All areas marked with protective tape.
- ♥ Unsupervised specialised equipment and all vehicles.

The property belongs to Scouts Queensland, we are guests and would like to ensure that we are welcome to come back. Please be considerate.

General rules:

- ♥ Children participating in activities away from main camping area must be under the direct supervision of a parent or nominated adult at all times.
 - ♥ If you must leave the camp vicinity for any reason, please advise CCS staff.
 - ♥ For your safety and protection SHOES, HATS and SUNSCREEN must be worn at all times. Protective head wear MUST be worn for all activities that require personal head protection. Rules of each activity must be adhered to on advice of the person/people running that activity.
 - ♥ FIRST AID is available from First Aid Room.
 - ♥ Please try to ensure that all rubbish is placed in the bins provided and not left on the ground.
 - ♥ Strictly NO ALCOHOL is to be consumed on the property.
 - ♥ If you need to leave camp before lunch on Sunday please notify the people who registered your arrival.
 - ♥ We would expect noise etc. to cease by 12.00 midnight.
 - ♥ Please consider other campers and keep the noise level to a minimum after this time.
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Camp Rules

Equipment:

Please ensure that no chairs or equipment are taken away from main dining area or any allocated areas.

Smoking policy:

Scouts Queensland have a strict no smoking policy, however there will be a specific area allocated. Please check with staff on arrival for smoking area.

For the health and safety of volunteers and campers, Childhood Cancer Support aligns itself with the Tobacco and Other Smoking Products Act 1998 and the Tobacco and Other Smoking Products Regulation 2016-2017.

Smoking policy cont:

As stated on the Queensland Health website: Laws in QLD include smoking bans for indoor and outdoor public places.

Changes from 1 September 2016 include:

- ♥ No smoking in national parks - it is now banned within 10 metres of in-use campsites and any public facilities
- ♥ Smoke free buffer increases to 5 metres at all non-residential building entrance, tents or sheds
- ♥ No smoking within 5 meters of children
- ♥ No smoking at outdoor public places
- ♥ No smoking anywhere inside
- ♥ No smoking at outdoor eating or drinking areas
- ♥ Electronic cigarettes cannot be used in no-smoking indoor and outdoor areas
- ♥ No smoking inside enclosed buildings, tents or sheds
